For students in Grades 5 to 8, we are asking for donations for Project Home as follows:

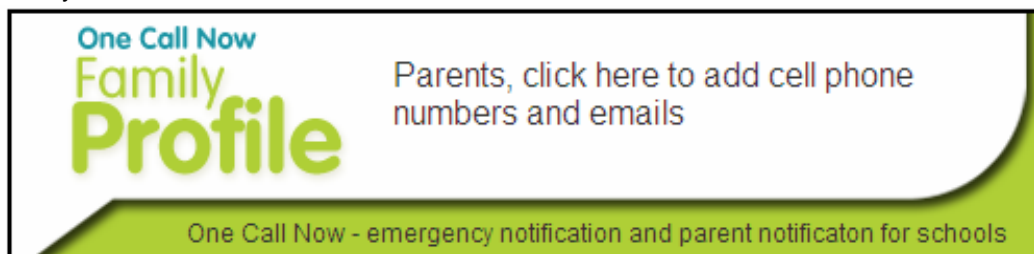
- Grade 5 – hot chocolate (individual servings) and tea bags

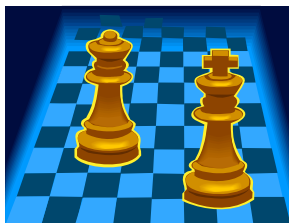
